ESA ESRIN: By popular demand, we are delighted to take our International conference and 30th Celebration to the European Space Agency's (ESA) ESRIN facility in Frascati, Italy. The home of European space science has been the host to the GRSG on two previous occasions and we believe it is a fantastic location for this year's event.

There will be 2 coffee breaks per day allowing time to view our posters and exhibition as well as a lunch in the ESRIN canteen (on delegates own account). This is a fantastic canteen offering a very wide range of food options, hot and cold and is heavily subsidised. Our long lunch breaks will also allow time for you to view our live demos, posters and network.

Please remember to bring ID (passport/driving license) with you for the first day of the conference for ESA security.


Transportation to the conference: Free shuttle buses will be provided for all delegates (included in the ticket price) to get both to and from ESA ESRIN and from the dinner. These will depart from the central square in Frascati. The shuttle bus timetable is below:

For those wishing to walk it is approximately a 30 minute downhill walk from central Frascati to ESA ESRIN. Local taxis are also available and your hotel will be happy to arrange that for you.



Security: Please note that owing to security at ESA ESRI all delegates will be registered with the security office in advance. Please bring ID with you for reference in case it is needed (only needed for day 1 and for partners attending the welcome drink at the end of day 1). Once you have your delegate badge your ID will no longer be required.

9th December, Icebreaker reception: Please join us for our informal icebreaker reception which is a great way to meet the team, catch up with old friends and make new ones before the conference starts. This is open to all delegates (and partners) in central Frascati. This year it will be held at the [Flanagan's pub, Frascati](#) (Via Felice Grossi Gondi,6, 00044 Frascati RM, Italy). A welcome drink and light food will be provided and there is also a cash bar (and full menu).






Location Map:

 - 20-30mins taxi ride to Frascati
- **Rome Fiumicino:**
 - 45mins – 1 hour taxi journey
 - Trains from the airport via Rome Central station directly to Frascati
